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## *Titbits & Anecdotes from the second decade*

There is a well-known saying in the theatre, credited to WC Fields, “Never work with children or animals” inferring that they are scene stealers and completely unpredictable. In *The Barretts of Wimpole Street*, a Stirling Player’s dog, Van Dot, was cast as Elizabeth Barrett’s dog, Flush. Dot played her part very well in response to a gentle tug on her ribbon lead, until the performance where she saw her ‘dad’ in the front row and eagerly raced to the front of the stage wagging her tail enthusiastically, and not able to be easily distracted. But then, we all like approval for a job well done!

And then there was the wonderful ‘shoe construction’ for the production of *The Old Woman Who Lived in a Shoe* and the inclusion of a King Frog and his coterie of frog children. No animals, but the old woman’s children and the young frogs were justifiably scene stealers in a very enjoyable and successful show with an impressive shoe house.

In the production of *Cinderella*, the difficult timing of the costume change from ‘rags’ to ‘ball dress’ was overcome cleverly by using the leading lady’s twin sister who was waiting in the wings dressed to the nines!

In 1986 *The Great Mall Ball Space Caper*, written by a clever Stirling Player, involved many children in a story about the disappearance of the metal balls from our Rundle Mall and the trip into space to retrieve them. Upturned silver painted colanders with metal spikes and purple hair featured prominently!

The Tea Tree Players hosted a Festival of One Act Plays in 1987 which included both Adult and Youth Sections. The Stirling Players submitted a play in each section, *The Margarine Conspiracy* following its award for shared best actresses in the Hills Festival of One Act Plays and *Rainbow Over the Wall* in the Youth Section, specifically written by a Stirling Player for the event.

Toilet roll centres have been used in the theatre for the making of many props. For the 1989 production of *Separate Tables* they were used to make very credible lamps for each of the tables!

It is hard to forget the amazing puppets and the skill of the puppeteers in the production of *Gulls* as they flapped down the aisles of the theatre. In the words of Peter Goers “*the seagull puppeteers get in an appropriate flap in this superb production*”. Praise indeed!

In 1985, The Stirling Players production of *The Importance of Being Earnest* was dedicated to Wayne Larwood, a long time member of the group who tragically lost his life during that year

Also the *Charley’s Aunt* program in 1989 contained the following tribute: ‘*The Stirling Players mourn the passing of their esteemed member Max Grubel whose work for the players was done without fuss and little recognition. For years Max printed our programs and took the photos or videos of productions. His quiet support will be sadly missed*’. Max has certainly been missed.





## FOREWORD

This booklet is a compilation of flyers and cast/crew lists of The Stirling Players productions for the second decade of their existence from 1982 to 1991.

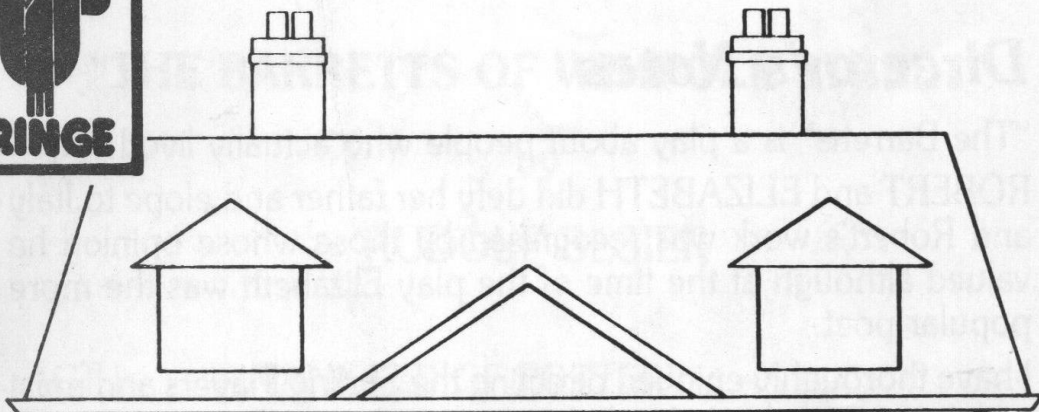
Over the decade the group continued to produce at least 2 full productions each year and in addition actively participate in the running and presentation of the Hills Festival of One Act Plays which was initiated by The Stirling Players in 1976. Six 'Hills' groups met annually at rotating hills venues to compete for the T.F. Lee trophy awarded for the 'best production'. In 1983 The Stirling Players were successful in winning the best production with its play *Heaven on Earth* and over the decade a further five awards for best actor or actress. Led by Tom Dyster and an enthusiastic sub-committee, the group hosted 3 festival weekends during 1982 to 1991. The number of competing groups steadily grew to nine and in 1991 the 16<sup>th</sup> Hills Festival of One Act Plays was hosted by the Galleon Theatre Group at Seacombe Gardens, highlighting the spread of its success.

Between 1985 and 1987 Tom Dyster wrote and directed simple fairy tales that were performed by a troupe of experienced adults and a small group of youngsters for Years 1, 2 and 3 school children. The troupe carried with it the required sets and props, mostly made by themselves, and performed on the classroom floor level to encourage the children's participation. The troupe's visits were always enthusiastically welcomed.

Several of The Stirling Players members were successfully mentored in trying their hand at directing during this decade. One 'new' director was heard to comment that, although daunting, she had learned a lot from directing a cast of experienced directors! A baptism of fire, perhaps!

The profits from The Stirling Players productions were put towards the costs of running and improving the facilities of the Stirling Community Theatre. The 1988 additions to the theatre included refurbishment of the foyer and auditorium which continue to provide a welcoming environment for theatre goers especially in winter when the wood fires are lit and free sherries are offered.

Enjoy this record of past shows. Hopefully it will stir pleasurable memories. The aim has been to depict the original flyers and cast/crew lists as authentically as possible. Some titbits of information and anecdotes from the early days are included on the facing page.
