Titbits & Anecdotes *from the fifth decade*

The March production of 2012, *Compleat Female Stage Beauty*, presented a new challenge for the group; - for the first time having to find actors happy to play a transgender role. An audition process that was an interesting new experience!

The second production, *Mr Bailey's Minder*, was the first amateur 'airing' of this hard-hitting, but heart-warming and optimistic play. The leading man's bow tie was reputedly the biggest ever seen!

The famous 'Vomitron' machine' in *God of Carnage* was designed and built by one of the male leads, a vet by day. It was later sold to a theatre company in NT.

The Lady in the Van cleverly portrayed 20years of life on a London Street, not to mention also successfully dealing with the logistics of bringing a 'van' onto the stage.

The Beaux' Stratagem was a costume extravaganza. These amazing costumes, specially made by an enthusiastic group of costumiers, have been used over and over again for many school and amateur theatre productions.

In the Australian play, *Inheritance*, projected images were included as part of the set for the first time. Photographs from a visit to the Mallee area provided a very effective backdrop for the production.

Two very different comedies, *Collaborators* in 2014 and *Zig Zag Street*, in 2015 attracted several actors 'new' to the Stirling stage. And the SP president made her 'directorial debut'.

Costumes for *Variation on a Theme* added more class to an already 'classy' play. The 'cement wall' was also suitably 'classy' but reportedly took a 'footy team' to erect!

The hired costumes for a very large cast in *Our Country's Good* fitted the bill perfectly. And all authentic! And then there was the costume challenge in *Our Man in Havana*, a story with many characters and many, many costume changes!

The set of *The Clean House* required a white lounge. Thanks to the expert negotiating skills of two of the production team, the ideal lounge was purchased at a 'bargain' price from Ikea. The addition of a musician on stage added to the play's ambience.

In 2019, *Nell Gwynn* was a colourful spectacular of song and dance with wonderful costuming, including the biggest and best hats you have ever seen!

In 2021, audiences appeared delighted to be able to 'belly laugh' at the panto-esque performance of *The Hypochondriac* and the cast obviously enjoyed providing them! A welcome 'pandemic diversion' despite the continued requirement for 'masks'.



FOREWORD

This book is a compilation of flyers and cast/crew lists of The Stirling Players productions for the fifth decade of their existence from 2012 to 2021.

Productions in the 40th anniversary year **in 2012** included *Compleat Female Stage Beauty* which involved a large cast (17) with multiple costume changes and an even larger crew to manage set design & construction. *Mr Bailey's Minder* with a much smaller cast was next. The story of a daughter's search for a live-in minder for her father, it took the audience on an emotional journey but also provided plenty of laughs.

God of Carnage, a challenging and hard-hitting play about inter-relationships and 'common' human behaviour, was the first **in 2013** and won awards for 'Best Comedy' and significantly, for 'Best Comedy Ensemble' reflecting the cohesiveness of its cast of four. And the second production, *The Lady in the Van*, was a great success attracting very receptive audiences and a very handsome profit!

In 2014, *Inheritance*, a drama about an outback Aussie family, a poignant story laced with plenty of good old Aussie humour, and the contrasting second production *Collaborators*, a dark comic drama were both well-received.

And the variety of plays continued;- **in 2015**, a restoration comedy (*The Beaux' Stratagem*) winning ATG awards for 'Best Costumes' and for 'Best Ensemble'.& an Aussie comedy (*Zig Zag Street*), **in 2016**, a 1950s French Riviera love affair (*Variation on a Theme*), & another Aussie play set in 1789 (*Our Country's Good*), **in 2017**, UK children sent to Aus after WW2 (*Forget Me Not*), & then a warm, wise comedy (*The Clean House*), **in 2018**, a quirky comedy about life (*R & G are Dead*) & fun in the world of espionage (*Our Man in Havana*) and **in 2019**, the spectacular historical female focus on 'acting' (*Nell Gwynn*) & a family's story (*Celebration*).

The ups and downs of COVID closures changed the theatre 'scene' **in 2020**. *Wicked Sisters* had to be abandoned midships, and the second scheduled production cancelled. In November, a short season of Aussie one act plays, *Dinky Di Double Bill*, was staged to COVID-limited audience numbers, and **in 2021**, the productions *Cosi* and *The Hypochondriac* played again to depleted (but appreciative) audiences.

Enjoy this record of past shows. Hopefully it will stir pleasurable memories. The aim has been to depict the original flyers and cast/crew lists as authentically as possible.
